## **Foot Care Nurses - Saskatoon**

### **PRIMARY FOCUS**

CBI Health Group is hiring a **Foot Care Nurses to join our team in Saskatoon. Casual and part time positions available.** The primary focus of this position is to provide Basic and/or Advanced Foot Care to CBI Health Group clients in their homes, clinics and facilities. The Foot Care Nurse is also CBI Health Group's representative to the public and customers and plays a key role in the success of all CBI Health Group programs.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Manage and conduct all aspects of foot care clinics operation according to the established highest quality care standards of practice.
- Manage and conduct all aspects of in-home foot care visits according to the established highest quality care standards of practice, including the most up to date infection prevention and control practices as determined by provincial guidelines and legislation.
- Co-ordinate and ensure all supplies/related equipment are secured, properly set up and fully operational.
- Create and maintain the related client documentation in accordance with set guidelines. This includes collection and submission of evaluation data.
- Teach and educate on foot care related topics.
- Determine and carry out appropriate advanced foot care nursing interventions.
- Be conscious of the hazards in the environment and act accordingly in meeting the safety and protection needs of the Client. In keeping with the Occupational Health & Safety Act, the Foot Care Nurse will take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the workplace is safe.
- Perform other duties as assigned and required from time to time.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Completion of a university, college or other approved registered nursing program.
- Completion of an approved Basic or Advanced Foot Care Training Program.
- Licensure by a provincial or territorial governing body of Saskatchewan.
- Some knowledge of Public Health / Community Nursing

### **WORKING ENVIRONMENT**

- Offsite at client settings i.e. home care / Retirement / Health Care facilities
- Risk of exposure to communicable diseases
- May encounter stressful situations
- Staff will be considered to be at work from the time of arrival at their first clinic/client until they leave their last clinic/client of the day, unless there is a break of longer than 3 hours between clinics. Staff will then be considered not to be at work from the time left the last clinic/client prior to the break until arrival at the first clinic/client following the break.

### **PHYSICAL AND MENTAL EFFORT**

- Lifting of equipment between 5lbs - 55lbs in and out of transportation
- Walking to and from transportation to carry equipment to clinic/private home
- Frequent and repeated bending

- Standing or sitting for prolonged periods of time
