

# Recognition Levels For SALPN Awards

Each year LPNs are eligible for four major awards. They are:

- Mentorship Award
- LPN of Distinction Award
- Lifetime Achievement Award
- Chapter Award

Each year non LPNs are eligible for the Honorary Member Award.

## Recognition levels with each award

1. Mentorship Award, LPN of Distinction Award, and Lifetime Achievement Award
  - a. Letter of notification from the Chair of the Awards & Recognition Committee to the nominators
  - b. Letter of congratulations from the Chair of the Awards & Recognition Committee to the recipient.
  - c. Free full AGM & Conference registration to the recipient to the AGM where the award is being presented
  - d. Recipient will received one free guest ticket for the banquet ceremony
  - e. Recognition at the Awards Banquet
  - f. Personalized trophy
  - g. Recognition in the Spring newsletter
2. Chapter Award
  - a. One free full AGM & Conference registration to the member accepting the award on behalf of the Chapter
  - b. Engraved trophy for the Chapter winner
  - c. Recognition at the Awards Banquet
3. Honorary Member Award
  - a. Letter of notification from the Chair of the Awards & Recognition Committee to the nominators
  - b. Letter of congratulations from the Chair of the Awards & Recognition Committee to the recipient.
  - c. Free full AGM & Conference registration to the recipient to the AGM where the award is being presented
  - d. Recipient will received one free guest ticket for the banquet ceremony
  - e. Recognition at the Awards Banquet
  - f. Personalized trophy
  - g. Recognition in the Spring newsletter

The Honorary Member is also entitled to the following as set out in Section 5 of the SALPN Regulatory Bylaws

- To hold himself or herself out as an honorary life member of the Association
  - To attend and participate in, but not vote at, all meetings of the Association
  - To be eligible for appointment to committees of the Association, but not to stand for or be elected or appointed to office
  - To receive any notices and newsletters from the Association
