1. POLICY

- 1.1 All IEN applicants must demonstrate proficiency in the English language and have supporting documentation provided directly to the SALPN from the testing centre.
- 1.2 English language proficiency tests are valid for 2 years after the testing date.
- 1.3 Approved English language proficiency tests are the Canadian English Language Benchmark Assessment for Nurses (CELBAN) and the International English Language Testing System (IELTS). The required proficiency scores are:

Writing	7	7.5
Speaking	8	7.5
Listening	10	8
Reading	8	7
