ORDER

Upon the application of legal counsel for the parties:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The formal complaint be amended by deleting paragraph 1 thereof and substituting the following:
 1. making inappropriate, flippant and misleading statements to the Assistant Registrar and the Registrar when responding to the questions posed to her on the random audit of her Continuing Education Points, which statements were inaccurate and resulted in an unnecessary dedication of time and resources by the staff of SALPN to the question of whether or not she had sufficient points to renew her licence in November 2011;
2. The Discipline Committee accepts the plea of guilty to the charge of professional misconduct set out in the formal complaint as amended; and
3. Pursuant to section 30 of *The Licensed Practical Nurses Act, 2000*:
 - a. Julie Cameron is formally reprimanded;
 - b. Julie Cameron shall at her own cost arrange for and successfully complete the course titled "Roles, Responsibilities and Ethics for LPNs" from the Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology (SIASST), provide written confirmation of enrollment to SALPN on or before September 15, 2013, and arrange for SIASST to provide written confirmation of successful completion of the course to SALPN on or before November 15, 2013, and, if not successfully completed on that date, her licence shall be suspended on and from that date and

until SIAST provides confirmation that she has successfully completed the course; and

- c. Julie Cameron shall pay costs in the amount of \$500.00, which amount is to be paid to SALPN in monthly instalments of \$100 payable on June 1, 2013 and on the 1st day of each month thereafter to and including October 1, 2013, and, if not paid on the date or dates required, her licence shall be suspended on and from that date and until the costs are paid in full.
